Dear Mr. Smith

I met with you in approximately 2012-2013 to discuss issues related to the now defunct Prince Edward County Children's Aid Society (PECAS), William Sweet – PECAS Executive Director, the unlawful practice of social work, systematic child abuse, etc.

You said that you would look into the issue of unlawful social work and get back to me after reviewing the information that I left with you and subsequently directed you to.

I have never, to my knowledge, received a letter or call back with regards to my concerns.

Since we last met, and as you surely know, William Sweet has been charged for his role in what I allege to be a community conspiracy whereby several professionals colluded to enable and/or to conceal child abuse.

I attempted to participate in a Ministry Review by the former Ministry of Child and Youth Services in approximately 2013, however; I was blocked from participating by David Remington. It appears that Mr. Remington now works under your direction as the head of the Child Welfare and Protection department under the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services.

Simply put, it's not difficult for me to see that a conspiracy and a subsequent cover-up has been playing out in my community, with regards to the former PECAS, for a number of years now.

I have informed the Crown Attorney and the OPP about concerns that I have in regards to conspiracy, cover-up, oppression tactics, etc.

The Crown and the OPP have failed the public to date from my perspective. As such, I've subsequently requested that the RCMP perform a federal investigation and that the Attorney General initiate an immediate Public Inquiry.

I've further informed the ITCCS of this situation whereby a human trafficking agency fronting as a child protection agency is being exposed in this area for that it really

is/was. So much of what Ontario CAS' are doing are not in-line with Federal, or international law. Ontario's children need you to be fully informed and to act in their best interests, and so far Mr. Smith, I don't think you've been listening to my valid concerns.

Now that you're the Minister of the CCSS I call on you to actually hear what I'm saying about how it literally 'took a village' to purport and protect the criminal activity of the former PECAS.

I expect you to support and to directly assist with, where appropriate, a federal police investigation and a Public Inquiry. It is the right thing to do!
